More Normalized Ride Starts Beginning Monday June 1

- Beginning June 1, we will return to a more <u>normalized ride</u> <u>start</u> at Barnes and Noble. Bradenton starts will follow on June 2. Ride starts are at 0800.
- Ride announcers will be at the <u>ride starts</u> and first time riders/guests may ride after signing the waivers. Announcements will be very brief consisting of rides for the day and a safety announcement as appropriate.
- Cyclists should <u>socially distance</u> at the ride start. Let's not give the appearance of a mass mob.
- Normal <u>club rules</u> for leader, sweep, and number of cyclists in a ride group apply.
- Leaders may still be in short supply. Cyclists who have not been cycling with others need to listen carefully to the ride announcements and choose a ride group that is appropriate for their experience, pace, and distance. This is particularly important if you have been off the bike for an extended period of time.
- Leaders and cyclists who are <u>not comfortable</u> with a large group start are free to continue to have their rides at other start locations, consistent with club protocols.
- Please respect social distance rules of the <u>break locations and</u> <u>any post ride locations</u>. This is particularly important if these areas are restaurants that need to utilize outdoor seating to serve their patrons.
- Bring <u>extra water</u> while cycling. It's hot and we have seen some dehydration problems. We hope to have the water fountains in The Villages back up and running by June 8th.
